

# Buzz Hockey Academy – Oct Midterm Camp 2020

## Procedures and Guidelines

1. Please be aware of social distancing at all times.
2. Each child will be allocated a camp group (prior to attending camp). Your child must stay with their group in their allocated area each day unless given permission by their groups COVID officer.
3. Your child will be told upon arrival on day 1 what group they are in (subject to change after first day of camp due to numbers etc). Name tags will be given to each child once they are inside the pitch area – where they will be directed to their designated area A/ B/ C/ D. They are then to remain with their group for the remainder of the day unless instructed by their COVID officer.
4. A site map has been circulated via our Facebook page and website. This map outlines group areas, specific directions for entering and exiting the site each day and carpark areas. The map must be viewed by all camp attendees before attending camp on day 1.
5. Set down areas will be marked when dropping your child(ren) off at camp. There will also be a strict one-way system in place to enter and exit the school and car park.
6. Where possible this procedure should be reserved for Junior Camp parents: If in exceptional circumstances you want to exit your car to speak to a coach and/or accompany your child to the pitch please proceed to CAR PARK AREA 1 (Nearest to the school). Please also be sure to leave sufficient space either side of your vehicle for social distancing measures.
7. It will be the intention of our COVID officers to spot check the temperature of several children in each group (at random) within the first 30 minutes of camp, each day. If your child is noted to have a raised temperature (30 degrees C or above) you will be contacted at asked to collect your child. They will not be permitted to attend camp that day.
8. Each child is required to bring TWO training tops with them. One white and one coloured – this is due to the use of bibs being banned. Changing areas will not be provided so your child should wear an under-top/vest of some sort, if desired, to allow comfortable pitch-side changing.

9. No sharing of food or drinks will be allowed. If siblings are in different designated areas they will need separate bags (for food, drink, clothes, equipment).
10. If your child needs to use the toilet at any stage of the day they must notify their assigned COVID officer. The officer will then explain the toilet procedures to your child.
11. Liquid soap, sanitisers and paper towels will be supplied.
12. Each child will strictly be required to dispose of their own rubbish (bottles, wrappers, paper towels) in the allocated bins provided.

### **IMPORTANT - Please note:**

- If your child is experiencing any form of the Corona Virus symptoms (coughing, sneezing, increased temperature etc) DO NOT SEND THEM TO CAMP. In this case, you must contact your child's COVID officer, notify them of your child's absence at camp that day and inform them of your child's general symptoms. This is to ensure the safety of the other children in your child's camp group.
- There will be a strict 15-minute time period allocated which should allow for orderly arrival and exit from the camp.
- Check the weather forecast! Please ensure your child is suitably attired for a day at camp (sun-cream/ rain coat/ gloves). Children and coaches will be required to remain at the pitch during the day and the pitch areas have very little cover.
- Gum shields and shin pads are essential for each child.
